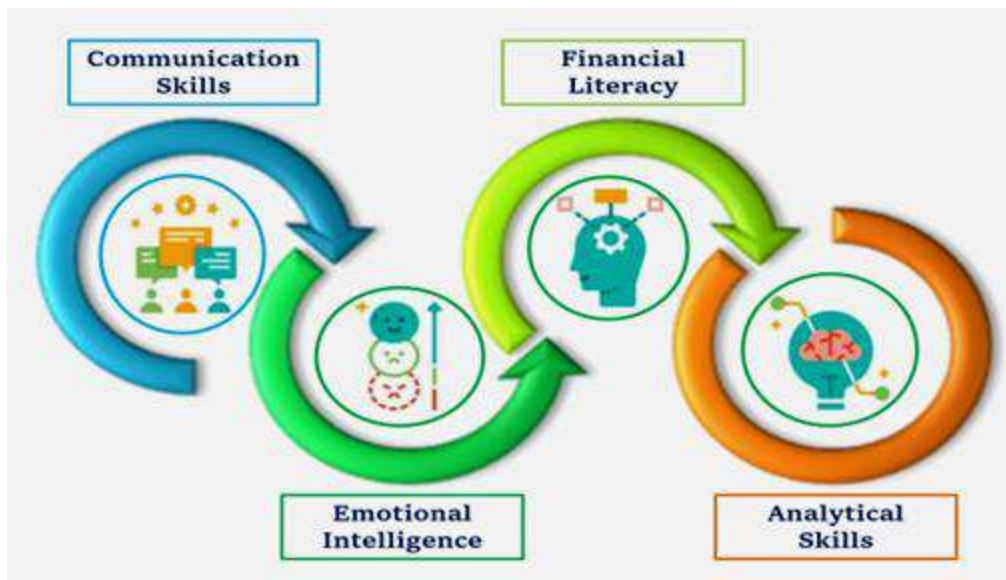
13. INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENTS

Several essential infrastructure enhancements were approved and implemented, including the construction of a ramp to the Biology lab on the first floor, CWSN restroom, workstations in the Chemistry lab, the provision of ramps for Children With Special Needs, and the expansion of our library's book collection from 3,000 to 5,020 books.
